Please note, that I'm interested of used (including CTO) stamps only. Mint stamps as well as items I already have in my collections, I will return back "as is".

CAUTION! Mailed letters must be standard sized (B4,C5,C6, C65 etc) and less than 2cm thick. Everything else is treated as parcel by Finnish post (meaning slower delivery as well as higher costs for me). I strongly recommend sending 100-300 stamps per exchange letter (though you can include more if you are sure everything will fit within the 2cm limit).

Do You live outside European Union? As of 1/1/2013, ALL NON-EU mail (including also gifts) sent to Finland is subject to customs revenue and VAT if the value (including stamps used for postage) exceeds US \$20. Make sure that the total value of your sending will not pass this limit, as **I WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY EXCHANGE LOTS THAT ARE HELD FOR REVENUE BY CUSTOMS!** To avoid any speculations about the value of stamps, please include customs sticker CN22 on back of cover (available freely at every post office worldwide) and state clearly the contents and value of your sending.

Use only postage stamps to pay postage. Avoid common issues as well as small sized definitives.
